

Guidelines for Global Village Participants

PRIDE Night, Friday, April 17th, 5:00-7:30 pm

Thanks for all your feedback; it has helped us come up with these guidelines:

There are two ways to participate in the Global Village (you can do EITHER or BOTH):

- 1) making a **TRIFOLD POSTER TABLE DISPLAY** on a country;
- 2) leading an **INTERACTIVE ACTIVITY**, such as a music or language demonstration; teaching a craft; telling a story; demonstrating a dance; or teaching a game. We're open to ideas!

1) TRIFOLD POSTER DISPLAY:

- Will be in cafeteria and gymnasium
- Not intended to include crafts, music, dance, games or storytelling
- Please try to have family members rotate through 30-45 minute shifts at your display to answer questions.
- NO FOOD PLEASE. The only exception is to display a plate of a typical food. But it must be covered with plastic wrap and have a sign "FOR DISPLAY ONLY—DO NOT EAT."
- We encourage you to bring decorative items, clothing, souvenirs, etc., but do not leave them unattended.
- We plan to organize 6-foot display tables around the four sides of pop-up canopies, from which you can hang textiles, lights or other decorations.
- Please let us know how much table space you would like. We will try to accommodate all requests.
- Tell us if you require an electrical outlet(s). **NOTE: if an extension cord is needed you will need to provide your own. The school does not have any extension cords that can be borrowed.*

2) INTERACTIVE ACTIVITY:

- Art rooms will be open for families to bring their own craft materials and set up instruction stations to teach others how to make a characteristic craft.
- The Library will have a stage and sound system for short (3-5 minute) demonstrations of dance or music.
- The Reading Garden will have a microphone for storytelling or teaching language phrases (3-5 minutes).
- The Science Room will be available for hosting indoor games.
- A program will be handed out so attendees will know where to go for various activities, including which countries will be represented there.
- Tell us as soon as you can if you need electrical outlets!

Please note:

- Laptop slideshows have not been popular in the past. People tend not to stay and watch them.
- The cafeteria stage will be occupied with a video montage and will not be available for any performances or country displays.
